

ANIMALS TO LOVE, copyright 2011 by Kathy McNeil

MATERIALS LIST for all the animals:

- Pressing sheet for fused applique.
 - Large ziplock bag.
 - 2 yd yards Lite Steam a Seam fusible product.
 - 4 inch or small size, sharp pointed scissors for cutting small complex shapes.
 - Sharpie fine point black marker.
- Ironing surface and travel iron if you have one.

FABRICS REQUIRED for Individual Patterns.

Pandas

26 x 28 inch sky piece 26 x 9 inch meadow or grass piece sew together before class

ADD EXTRA YARD OF STEAM A SEAM- This is a crib size quilt.

2/3yd of white. (Avoid sheer) 1/4 yd of creme white, or slightly darker in value than white white.

1/2 yd Black solid. 1/2yd of Dark batik or small scale print.

6 x 8 inch square of medium grey, 4 x 4 square of brown for eyes. Pink scrap for tongue.

Two different- 1/4 yds of green for fern. One lighter in value. Novelty small butterfly print for one to 3 butterflies. 1/4 yd of 2.5- 3 inch size flowers. You will fussy cut flowers and leaves from this.

Sea Turtle

32 x 21 background water batik. (lighter turtles show up better on dark background)

2 different sand fabrics- 1/4 yards

Top shell-1/4 yard of light lavender. -1/3 yard of green print for shell plates. Think turtle shell green!

Bottom shell, flippers, feet and head. -1/2 yard of light green batik with very little print.

On top of that you will place mosaic shapes in contrasting color. 1/3 yd for mosaic shapes.

Bottom shell plates- different medium color print.

1/4 yd medium to dark violet or green, for shell rim and darker face mosaic shapes.

Optional-coral reef fabrics with 3-6 inch images.

Bobcat

Back ground sky fabric, -1/2 yard . Desert floor fabric- 4 inch x 18.5 inches

Please sew together before class- sky 19 inch long by 18 1/2 inch wide -sewn -to 4 inch by 18 1/2 inch strip at the bottom for desert.

Tree- 2-3 1/4 yards of tree bark fabric. You may add even more scraps from your stash.

Eye and Leaf fabric, approximately 8 inch square. Teal to emerald green batiks work well.

Canyon lands- 5 inch wide scraps of red rock/canyon land colored fabric.

Bobcat fabric,- 1/4 yard of golden brown or tan fabric. Swirly small scale prints work best. Approximately 8 inch square of dark golden brown or tan fabric. (Should be same color family as the main bobcat fabric, just darker). Supplement your chosen fabrics with other similar colored scraps from your stash so we can create shadows. Nose -2 inch patch of brownish pink. Make sure there is enough contrast between tree and cat fabric so they don't blend together.

Approximately 8 inch square each; white, light tan or beige, and light golden brown fabric.

Humming bird

Back sky ground fabric. Pre-cut and bring 19 x 23.

Vine fabric-1/2 yard Leaf fabric 1/4 yard - variegated green works well, so you can vary the value of the leaves.

Flowers- 4 - 1/4 yards of 2-3 inch scale size flower petal fabrics. Variety of light, mediums and dark petals from similar color family. It is the 2-3 inch petals that you are looking for.

Birds- multiple small scraps, 6 inch wide approximately.

Look at pictures of the variety of species and colors. If you like the ruby throated variety-- use the same color you used for your flowers, for their throats.

Shiny synthetics- 4 x 4- that hold up to heat from your iron are fun to use for throats!

Three to Four different medium to darker green gray. Use batiks or small scale prints.
