STUDENT SUPPLY LIST FOR "THE SKYSCAPE QUILT"

Each student must bring:

Painting supplies:

- 2 natural sponges about the size of your hand.
- Cheap 1"- 4" natural bristle brushes and sponge brushes. (Home Depot, Lowes, etc.)
- apron (or wear old clothes)
- a couple dozen rubber gloves (disposable doctor-type from pharmacy work best)
- Three 20" X 30" pieces of 1/4' or 3/8' thick FoamCore (art supply store or Staples)

- Cover the FoamCore smoothly on one surface with Contac (tm.) paper (hardware store, K-Mart. etc.)
OR BRING
- Light-weight plastic drop cloth (1.0 mil., Ace Hardware, Lowe's, Home Depot, etc.), cut into 16 -20 pieces, approx. 2ft. X 1.5 ft. Clear or white plastic only, please

- About 3 yards of good white 100% cotton fabric, not muslin. Broadcloth is a nice weight. It's not necessary to prewash fabric if drops of water sink immediately into the fabric. However, if drops of water sit on the surface, prewash fabric with detergent or choose a different or PFD fabric. No need to iron.
- A dozen or so straight pins and push pins
- Permanent marking pen, scissors, paper towels
- 10-15 half-pint cottage cheese-style containers or 12 snack-size "Gladware"- style containers, a couple large enough for sponges and large brushes to fit into
- Plastic plant mister or spray bottle (Make sure it "mists.")

Sewing supplies:

- Pencils, template plastic, fabric and paper scissors, push pins, straight pins, masking tape.
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler, one piece of Cotton Classic or other cotton batting about 4 feet by 4 feet. This will be used as a "working wall" or on a "working wall." Polyester batting is not suitable.
- No sewing machines.
