Skill Level: ___ Beginner X Easy ___ Intermediate

Fabric requirements for a lap size quilt (56 1/2" x 64 1/2")

5" dark squares 56 pairs

5" med squares 56 pairs

5" light squares 56 pairs (shirtings or other background)

A pair is two squares of the same fabric.

If you wish to make a larger size please refer to page 51 in the book *Nickel Quilts* for materials needed.

Be sure to have your 5" squares cut before coming to class. You don't need to have all of them cut but you should have at least enough for 10 blocks. One block uses 1 pair of dark squares, 1 pair of medium squares, and 1 pair of light squares.

Save any leftover pieces you may have at the end of your 5" strips after cutting it down into 5" squares and bring them to class. I have a great project for them!

Basic supplies:

- Sewing machine (bring extra needles)
- Basic Sewing Kit: scissors, pins, thread, seam ripper
- Rotary cutter (with sharp blade) and mat
- Rulers: 6" square or a 6 x 12"
- Iron and small ironing surface
- Design wall/surface (optional)*
- Power strip and extension cord
- Notepad & pencil
- A copy of *Nickel Quilts, Great Designs from 5" Scraps*
- 10 paper plates - 9" or 10" size

*If you bring the supplies listed below I will show you how to put your design wall together.

- 1 dressmaker's cardboard cutting board (the kind that folds up for storage)
- 2 curtain rods that extend to at least 72" (the white metal ones that curve on each end)
- a piece of white flannel 44" x 80" or a flannel backed vinyl tablecloth
- 10 large binder clips 2" size (from the office supply store)
